Dear Parent/Carer

Year 4/5 & 5/6 Chester Zoo Visit

As part of our topic work this term we are planning a visit to Chester Zoo.

The trip will take place on Thursday 2nd March. We shall leave school at 9:00am, as we have a full day of activities and workshops planned, so don't be late! We should arrive back at school at approximately 5:30pm traffic permitting.

The children will need a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate) for those children who have free school meals a packed lunch can be provided. As it will be a full day the children may bring a healthy snack for the morning. **Please could their lunches be packed in either plastic containers or disposable packaging, and placed in a rucksack type bag, as they will be responsible for carrying this with them all day.**

The children will need to wear full school uniform, along with a waterproof coat and appropriate footwear. Please be aware of the weather on the day of the trip and make sure your child is dressed appropriately.

Mobile phones are not allowed. Please do not send them with any money as there will not be an opportunity for them to spend it.

If children need to take travel sickness medication please administer before bringing them to school. If they require another dose for the return journey please complete a medicine request form (available from reception) and give the form and medication to your child's class teacher.

The full cost of the visit is £18 however; the fundraising which took place last term enables us to reduce the cost per child. This means in order for the trip to go we need a contribution of £15.00 for each child. Thanks to the efforts of our fundraising team we didn't have to cancel any trips last year and, as the visits we plan are all organised with a view to enhancing your child's learning, that is a great achievement.

If you do have any difficulties with the contribution you must speak to us at your earliest convenience. If we do not receive enough contributions by **Friday 9th February** then, unfortunately, **the trip will have to be cancelled.**

We can only offer trips and activities with the support of all the parents. If we do not receive enough contributions then unfortunately the trip will have to be cancelled.
