

Welcome back to school!

The staff and governors at Queenswood are excited to welcome ALL children back to school this week.

Queenswood Primary has produced a robust plan to ensure we all keep safe. Inside school there are many new infection control procedures; please make sure you play your part by remembering the arrangements below:

Do:

- ✓ Early Years and Key Stage 1: wait on the bottom playground at the start and end of the day
- ✓ KS2: wait on the top playground at the start and end of the day. (Year 5 and 6 parents please leave and meet your children at the school gates)
- ✓ Only 1 parent to bring children to school
- ✓ Stand 2 metres away from all other families and teaching staff

Do not:

- × Arrive earlier or later than the 8:30–8:40 am drop off times
- × Arrive earlier or later than the collection times:
Nursery and Reception: 2:40pm
Key Stage 1: 2:50pm
Key Stage 2: 3:00pm
- × Hang around on the playground or at the school gates talking with family and friends (you will be politely asked to move on)

What your child needs:

- School uniform
- Water bottle (this must be taken home daily for washing)
- If bringing packed lunch, this must be brought by the child at their start time—staff cannot deliver lunchboxes to classrooms later in the day
- PE kit on their PE days (this is currently Wednesday for all pupils except EYFS)
- School bag, if necessary
- Waterproof coat
- Trainers that can remain in school to allow daily outdoor activity


If you need to talk to us:

Only enter school if absolutely necessary and then only through the school office

Only 1 person at a time will be allowed in the school office

Use the hand sanitizer before entering the building

If you need to speak to a teacher at the end of the day, this will be outside at a 2 metre distance



If children are travelling to school on public transport, then they must wear a mask. On entry to school they must dispose of the mask in then lidded bin in the classroom immediately and wash their hands. If it is a re-useable mask, then the child must keep this in a sealed plastic bag.
