Home Learning Plans - Autumn 2020

Introduction:

The school will respond to a suspected case of Covid 19 by following the guidance from Public Health England and advice from the local Public Health Panel. The advice could include instructing bubbles of pupils to stay home for 14 days. In these circumstances the plan is to continue to provide a learning at home.

Each teacher has produced a home learning plan for their cohort and this has been agreed at a full staff meeting and these plans will be in place for the Autumn term 2020.

Home Learning plan for the Early Years.

Staff will make use of the White Rose Early Years Home Learning that is based on a book. This will cover maths/ literacy/ physical development/ creative across the week.

The teacher will provide a virtual daily online introduction/ shout outs to the children.

The teachers will also provide a story that the children vote for on a daily basis.

Children will be provided with a weekly Physical development challenge linked to gross and fine motor skills.

A daily phonics bitesize lesson will be taught by the teacher – the content will be dependant on the time of the term/ year.

To develop British Values and SMSC the teacher will provide Early Years Picture News presentations for use at home.

Via Class Dojo

Daily phone call – to those children who have limited internet – Head . To ensure they are engaging with the home learning.

Willow Class (Year 1/2/3)

Teacher will provide daily video input explaining the learning she would like the children to complete, using the Do Jo facility.

The focus will be on maths, literacy and a foundation subject. It will be sourced from Oak Academy, BBC Bitesize, White Rose and other worksheets produced by the teacher.

When work has been completed it will be recognised through the submission of Do Jo points.

The teacher will provide a daily story.

Parents who will require home learning pack

Work will be emailed into school at the beginning of the week by the teacher for a pack to be printed.

Three children will require home learning packs- Hala, Mya and Mason.

Home Learning Plan for the Maple Class (Years 3/4)

The teacher will provide a daily video greeting and explanation of the days learning.

Daily – Literacy , Maths and Foundation subject.

Lesson drawn from Oak Academy where appropriate and enhanced using the White Rose, BBC education and Twinkl resources.

The children are to post work into the Do Jo portfolios for feedback – any missing work will be challenged by the teacher and Do Jo points will be awarded for completion and quality.

The teacher will provide a daily recorded story and use this as an opportunity to share/ celebrate work on the class story.

Daily reading with parents will be encouraged- parents will post evidence instead of signing diaries.
